Skill up your Future! With YFU

Youth For Understanding is looking for 1 dedicated **European Solidarity Corps volunteers** to join us in the Global Office in Brussels for 1 year!

The volunteer in this project will have the chance to be involved in YFU biggest event, the YES! (Young European's Seminar), enhance Advocacy skills, and increase their knowledge in Marketing and Communication.

In addition, they will have the opportunity to learn about long-term Intercultural Exchanges worldwide, by participating in some operations involved in the organisation of such experiences.

This experience will offer the selected volunteers the chance to get an insight into how a Global NGO operates. They will have the opportunity to work with very different departments of the organisation, expanding their knowledge of different fields, according to their professional interests.

Starting date: Preferably, you should be relocated to Brussels and ready to start 1st September 2020, but negotiable. Applications will be processed on a rolling basis, therefore we encourage you to apply as fast as possible.

Tasks of the volunteers

1. Support the Communication and Marketing work

- ✓ Support with increasing the visibility of the GOs' activities (social media posts, newsletters etc.)
- ✓ Support in implementing the Branding of YFU worldwide
- ✓ Support in producing visual material (**here you will have the chance to develop your skills in programs like Adobe InDesign, Illustrator, Premier and Photoshop**)

2. Support the implementation of the Young European's Seminar (YES) - biggest YFU event in the world!

- ✓ Support with putting together narrative and financial grant reports, according to the funders/organizations' needs for this event;
- ✓ Support with communication with volunteers and participants and Member Organisations regarding logistics
- ✓ Support in the implementation (logistics, vendor's management etc.)
- ✓ Support promoting YES 2021

3. Support Advocacy and Fundraising activities

- ✓ Support in current and future advocacy campaigns and initiatives
- ✓ Support in the research for potential donors for the organization
- ✓ Support in raising funds for YFU's activities

Logistical arrangements

The intern will be expected to be in the office on a full-time basis, according to the Belgian law 38h/week.

EEE-YFU will provide a **monthly allowance of 910 euro**, which will enable you to secure accommodation and subsistence during your stay in Brussels. We will support you with helpful indications, but it will be your responsibility to secure these during your internship.

Travel to and from Brussels for relocation will be covered by the program. All travels and subsistence during assigned events will be fully covered.

The internship will last for 12 months.

Eligibility criteria:

- Between 18 and 30 years old
- National or resident of one of the EU countries, [Non-EU Programme Countries](#), or [Partner countries neighbouring the EU](#).
